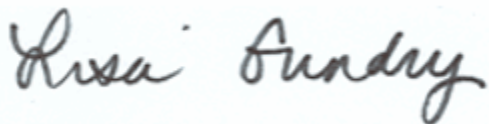

R 400.8176(4)	At the time of the inspection, the cots being used were not adequate size. Ms. Jones stated that she would order new cots.	Children will have appropriate cots.	5/29/2024
R 400.8143(3)	At the time of the inspection, some of the children did not have completed immunization records prior to initial attendance. Ms. Jones acknowledged that she wasn't aware of this requirement and thought she had 30 days. She agreed to start getting these records before the children start attending.	All children's files will be complete.	Immediately and ongoing.

R 400.8143(6)	At the time of the inspection, some of the children did not have completed physical records within 30 days of initial attendance. Ms. Jones acknowledged that she some were overdue, and she indicated that she requests the records but doesn't always get them in a timely manner. She agreed to start getting these records within the required timeline.	The children's files will be complete.	Immediately and ongoing.
R 400.8330(22)	At the time of the inspection, I observed an infant in their crib with a bottle.	Children will not have beverages in sleep equipment.	Immediately and ongoing

It is expected that the corrective action plan will be implemented within the time frames as outlined in your plan. A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.
