All bottles will be labeled with the child's first AND last names. We will make sure all bottles are dated with the correct date. If needed, we will look into getting a digital calendar to hang/display by the refrigerator to ensure the correct date is used when labeling.	01-29-2024
R 400.8143(1)	Incomplete child information cards.	We will make sure all child information cards are properly filled out when completed by parents. If needed, we will start having parents fill out forms in the office instead of at home and returning them incomplete.	01-29-2024


R 400.8161(5)	The center did not complete the required fire drills in 2023.	The director will make sure all drills are written down on the log sheet. We will have another staff member monitor the log sheets, as well, as a check system.	01-29-2024
R 400.8112(2)(b)	One child care staff member did not sign part 3 or part 4 of the consent and disclosure form.	We will make sure all staff members completely fill out their paperwork and consent/disclosure forms upon hire and also every five years when fingerprint renewals are done.	01-29-2024

It is expected that the corrective action plan will be implemented within the time frames as outlined in your plan.

A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.
