R400.8330(23) Food services and nutrition generally.	On February 7, 2023, in the Toddler I Classroom, I observed Child B walking around the classroom and drinking from a green water bottle.	It is not the child care center policy to allow children to walk around with cups or food. There will be no child walking around with any food or cup. The program director and child care staff members reviewed the protocols regarding health and safety, and food and drink policies. The guidelines will be posted in the Toddler area.	Immediately.

R 400.8134(2)(e) Hand washing.	On March 9, 2023, CCSM 5 changed two children's diapers in the Infant Classroom. CCSM 5 did not wash her hands after each diapering.	The child care staff members will wash their hands after each diapering, and before and after toileting.	Immediately.
R 400.8134(3)(b) Hand washing.	On March 9, 2023, CCSM 5 changed two children's diapers in the Infant Classroom. CCSM 5 did not wash the children's hands after diapering.	The child care staff members will wash the children's hands after each diapering. The child care staff members will help support and encourage all children to wash their hands including infants.	Immediately.
R400.8350(2) Toilets; hand washing sinks.	On March 9, 2023, CCSM 5 and CCSM 6 both said the portable hand washing sink in the Infant Classroom has not been operable for the past three weeks.	The program director was aware of the portable hand washing issue and was working to fix the sink. The water is hard, and it wears out the sink hardware. The hand washing sink was fixed. The child care staff members were informed to use the portable hand washing located in the adjoining room while the sink was being repaired.	Immediately.

It is expected that the corrective action plan will be implemented within the time frames as outlined in your plan.

A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.
