II. Purpose of Addendum

The terms of the original license have been modified on 02/02/2015, 10/31/2017 and 01/14/2021.

On 01/12/2021, Program Director Michelle Klein requested to add the library for approved child use space. She is not requesting any change to the capacity of the license.

III. Methodology

01/12/2021 Inspection completed On-Site

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

Perry Public Schools Child Care Center operates in the Perry Elementary School building in the city of Perry. The program is sponsored by the Perry Public Schools. The building continues to be used as an elementary school with kindergarten through fourth grade.

Approved space: The program will be utilizing four classrooms and the cafeteria and gym located in the Perry Elementary School Building.

- **Room 1** measures 34' x 30' for a total of 1020 square feet. This is more than enough space for the requested capacity of 24 children, age 30 months to 12 years.
- **Room 2** measures 29' x 26', plus 10' x 12', plus 7' x 6' for a total of 916 square feet. This is more than enough space for the requested capacity of 12 children, age birth to 36 months.
- **Room 3** measures 29' x 24', plus 15' x 6', plus 7' x 6' for a total of 828 square feet. This is more than enough space for the requested capacity of 18 children, ages 30 months to 12 years.
- **Room 4** measures 29' x 24', plus 15' x 6', plus 7' x 6' for a total of 828 square feet. This is more than enough space for the requested capacity of 18 children, ages 30 months to 12 years.
- **Room 24** measures 28' x 27' for a total of 756 square feet. This is more than enough space for the requested capacity of 18 children, 30 months to 12 years of age.

- **Cafeteria** measures 64' x 48' for a total of 3,072 square feet. This is more than enough space for the requested capacity of 45 children, 30 months to 12 years of age.
- **Gym** was not measured but is larger than the cafeteria. There is more than enough space to be used for any group of children.
- **Library** measures 46' x 26' for a total of 1,196 square feet. This is more than enough for the requested about of 45 children, 30 months to 12 years of age.

Equipment: There is more than enough varied equipment and materials for the requested capacity of 100 children. An equipment inventory list was provided by the licensee.

Number of sinks and toilets: There are 18 toilets and 13 hand washing sinks. This supports the center's capacity of 100.

Outdoor play area: The outdoor play area is located in the middle of the classroom wings. It is entirely fenced and has a climber, sandbox, playhouse and two picnic tables. A parking lot will be coned off and used for the riding toys.

There is no water hazards present on the premises.

Documentation if a lead hazard risk assessment was required and the results: A lead hazard risk assessment was completed on 06/13/2014 by Burt Russell of Compli-Chek Environmental Compliance, LLC. No hazards were discovered.

Documentation of playground safety: A playground safety inspection was completed on 08/04/2014 by Sean Kribs. A BCAL-5047 Playground Inspection Certification Summary was completed by Mr. Kribs and all equipment to be used by the center is in compliance.

Terms: The center is approved for 100 children age birth to 12 years of age.


Proposed days and hours of operation: The program will operate full time, year-round. The hours are Monday through Friday, from 6:00 a.m. until 6:00 p.m.

Full or part time: Full time care will be provided for all children. There are also two GSRP classrooms with one operating all day and the other operating ½ day, four days a week.

Other program components: Transportation will be provided by the Perry Public Schools. There is no swimming. Food service will be provided by Perry Public Schools.

V. Recommendation

I recommend the addition of the library to approved space for children use, ages 30 months to 12 years. The license capacity will remain at 100.
