According to child care staff members (CCSM's) Brenda Cantrell and Marilyn Walters, the droppings are primarily found in the upper cupboards and cabinet drawers. When they locate them, they clean and sanitize the area. They	The center is working with the landlord and setting mouse traps, that are checked daily by CCSM's. The traps are not accessible to the children. During spring break, the center will hire an exterminator, if needed. The center will continue to monitor for mice and the steps will be repeated until they are gone.	03/32/2023

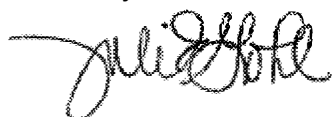
