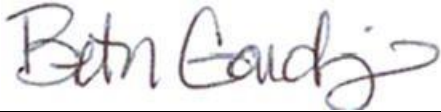

The licensee is not performing monthly inspections with initial and date of check on fire extinguishers.	Violation Established

R 400.8152(6)	Medication; administrative procedures. A child care staff member shall give or apply any prescription or nonprescription medication according to the directions on the original container, unless otherwise authorized by a written order of the child's physician.	The infant classroom was dispensing an over the counter medication which indicated that children under two need a doctor's authorization without a prescription and only parental authorization. Another over the counter medication indicated that dosage amount was less than the amount parent indicated to dispense. Must follow over the counter medications unless have a prescription/physician authorization.	Violation Established
R 400.8340(3)	Food services and nutrition; provided by parents. Breast milk, formula, milk, other beverages, and food furnished in a same-day supply s must be covered and labeled with the child's first and last name and the date.	The lunch bags for toddlers did not include the child's last name and date.	Violation Established

R 400.8176(17)(b)	Bedding must not come in contact with other bedding.
R 400.8176(12)	A tightly fitted bottom sheet must cover the crib or porta-crib mattress with no additional padding placed between the sheet and mattress.
R 400.8161(2)(b)	A plan for safely moving children to a relocation site.
