R 400.8140(1)	Ms. Wasielewski did not provide positive methods of discipline when she grabbed Child A's chin to get him to look at her. There is not enough evidence to find that Ms. Wasielewski grabbed Child A's wrist and cause a bruise.	I did not grab the child's chin but rather move it gently to guide him to look at me. In the future I will sit down with the child and work with him until he is ready to talk and work out a solution with me. R 400.8125(1)	CCSM 1 and CCSM 3 did not provide appropriate care and supervision when Child A was left alone in the bathroom for five to ten minutes without being checked on.	We had a meeting with the two staff members on April 2nd to discuss appropriate classroom management. The Director has been working in the classroom and modeling classroom supervision which has helped with seeing where they should be moving around the classroom and checking in frequently. The Director and Assistant Director will continue to monitor the Assistants classroom management.	04/02/2024
R 400.8140(2)(e)	CCSM 1 and CCSM 3 deprived Child A of his lunch when he pushed another child out of his chair.	The Assistants will take the Miregistry class Discipline and Child (Positive Discipline) course #125791 within the next 3 weeks as well as work with the child's therapist on specific strategies for him.	05/20/2024
