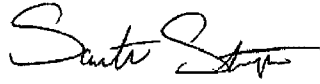

III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children's records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During my onsite inspection I observed large group, free play, lunch and rest time. Interactions between child care staff members and child care children were positive.

During the inspection, the center was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

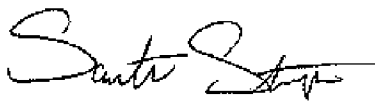
R 400.8152 Medication; administrative procedures.

(5) A child care staff member shall keep all medication out of the reach of children and shall return it to the child's parent or destroy it when the parent determines it is no longer needed or it has expired.

Medication was stored in the infant classroom that expired in September of 2022 and wasn't discarded or returned to the parents.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular child care license to this center.
