IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

Play and Learn rents space from Evangelical Homes of Michigan and the shares the building with their skilled nursing facility. The center is comprised of 10 classrooms and the multipurpose/lunchroom.

All classrooms are located on the same hallway. The following rooms are located on the west side of the hallway:

- Room #1 H10(Toddler Room) is 21ft. x 11 ft., providing a total of 231 square feet. At 35 square feet this accommodates a total of 7 children. At 50 square feet this accommodates 5 children. This room is currently utilized for children 1 ½ -2 years of age.
- Room #2 (Preschool Room) is 21ft. x 11 ft., providing a total of 231 square feet. At 35 square feet this accommodates 7 children. This room is currently utilized for children 2 ½-3 years of age.
- Room #3 (Preschool Room) is 21ft. x 11 ft., providing a total of 231 square feet. At 35 square feet this accommodates 7 children. This room is currently utilized for children 2 ½-3 years of age.
- Room #4 (Preschool Room) is 21ft. x 11ft., providing a total of 231 square feet. At 35 square feet this accommodates 7 children. This room is currently utilized for children 4 years of age.
- Room #5 (Preschool Room) is 21ft. x 11ft., providing a total of 231 square feet. At 35 square feet this accommodates 7 children. This room is currently utilized for children 2 ½-3 years of age.

The following room are located on the east side of the hallway:

- Room #6 A-9 (Toddler/PK) is 21ft. x 11ft., providing a total of 231 square feet. At 35 square feet this accommodates a total 7 children. At 50 square feet this accommodates 5 children. This room is currently utilized for children 2-3 years of age.
- Room #7 (Toddler Room) is 21ft. x 11ft., providing a total 231 square feet. At 50 square feet this accommodates a total of 5 children. At 35 square feet this accommodates a total of 7 children. At 50 square feet this

accommodates a total of 5 children. This room is currently utilized for children 12-18 months of age.

- Room #8 (Infant Room) is 21ft. x 11ft., providing a total of 231 square feet. At 50 square feet this accommodates a total of 5 children. At 35 square feet this accommodates 7 children. This room is currently utilized for children 4-6 months of age.
- Room #9 (Infant Room) is 21ft. x 11ft., providing a total of 231 square feet. At 50 square feet this accommodates a total of 5 children. At 35 square feet this accommodates 7 children. This room is currently utilized for children 6 months-12 months of age.
- Room #10 (Toddler Room) is 21ft. x 11 ft., providing a total of 231 square feet. At 50 square feet this accommodates a total of 5 children. At 35 square feet this accommodates 7 children. This room is currently utilized for children 12months-18 months of age.

The following room is additional child use space and not included in the total licensed capacity:

- The multipurpose activity room/school- age/lunchroom is 51ft. x 28ft., providing a total of 1,428 square feet. At 35 square feet this accommodates a total of 41 children. At 50 square feet this accommodates a total of 29 children.

The licensee designee and program director understand that the total licensed capacity is 70 children 0-12 years. They also understand that per child care licensing rule 400.8183(7), when there are children of mixed ages in the same room or well defined space then the ratio and group size is determined by the age of the youngest child. Also, each room shall not exceed the determined capacity of the room.

The total space is sufficient for a total center capacity of 70 children, 0-12 years of age.

There are a total of 10 hand washing sinks and 10 toilets for child use. This supports the center's capacity.

The classrooms are furnished with a variety of developmentally appropriate equipment. There is an adequate amount of equipment to support the center's capacity.

On 11/12/2021, an environmental health inspection was completed as part of the renewal inspection, which included all the approved child use space. On 10/25/2019, a fire inspection was completed for the entire child care center. On 10/13/2015, a lead risk assessment was completed.


Terms:

The center is approved for a total capacity of 70 children 0-12 years of age.

The center provides field transportation for school age children. Swimming is not provided. The center does prepare food on-site.

V. Recommendation

I recommend the continued use of rooms #1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10 and the multipurpose/school-age/lunchroom.
