II. Purpose of Addendum

Program director, Kimberly Andrew submitted a modification request to switch the designated infant room with the designated toddler room. The lower level was also remeasured, as it has been divided into well defined spaces for two age groups.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

The terms of the license have been modified on July 7, 2020, and July 29, 2022. First Foundation Early Learning Center is a two story building located in Saline, MI. On July 29, 2022, the following rooms were remeasured.

The main level consists of the following two rooms:

- New Infant Room is 43ft. x 18 ft., providing a total of 774 square feet. This room accommodates 15 children ages 0-2 ½ years of age. The maximum group size for children birth to 30 months of age is 12 children.
- New Toddler room is 42ft. x 11ft., providing a total of 462 square feet. This room accommodates 9 children ages 12 months-2 ½ years of age and 13 children over 2 ½ years of age.

The lower level consists of the following rooms:

- Kitchen Room is 13ft.x 10ft., providing a total of 260 square feet. This room accommodates 5 children ages 2-3 years of age.
- Room 1 is 14ft.x 18ft., providing a total of 250 square feet. This room accommodates 5 children ages 2-3 years of age. This room is adjacent to the kitchen and will be utilized as one room.
- Room 2 and Snack Room is 20ft. x 28ft., providing 560 square feet. This room accommodates 16 children 3- 12 years of age.

The following room is additional child use space and not included in the total licensed capacity

- Cubby Room is 10ft.x 11 ft., providing 110 square feet. This room was not included in the capacity.

The licensee designee/program director understand that the total licensed capacity is 50 children 0-12 years. They also understand that per child care licensing rule 400.8182(7),

when there are children of mixed age group in the same room or well-defined space then the ratio and group size is determined by the age of the youngest child.

The total space is sufficient for a total capacity of 50 children, 0-12 years of age.

There are a total of 4 toilets and 4 hand washing sinks available for child use. This supports the center's capacity.

The classrooms are furnished with a variety of developmentally appropriate equipment. There is an adequate amount of equipment to support the center's capacity.

On July 25, 2022, an environmental health inspection was completed as part of the modification process. A lead inspection was completed for the entire child care center on April 22, 2022.

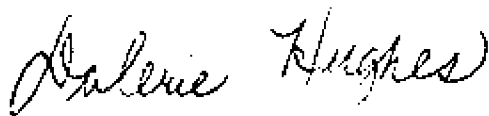
Terms:

The center is approved for a total capacity of 50 children age 0-12 years.

The center provides field trip transportation. Swimming is not provided. The parents provide lunches, and the center provides snacks.

V. Recommendation

I recommend the switch of the designated infant room with the designated toddler room. I also recommend the use of the well defined spaces on the lower level.
