During the onsite inspection on February 14, 2023, primary 2 classroom did not follow the required child care staff member to child ratio of 1 to 12 for preschoolers, 4 years of age. R400.8182 (7) Ratio and group size requirements.	On January 3, 2023, Child A age 30 months was in the primary 2 classroom with 20 children ranging in age from 4 years to 6 years of age with two child care staff members. The required child care staff member to child ratio of 1 to 8 and maximum group size of 16 was not maintained as required based on the age of the youngest child in the room with mixed age ranges.	The center will maintain ratio based on the youngest child in the Primary 2 classroom with children ranging in age from 4 years to 6 years.	02/14/2023
