IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

The current activity room will serve as a toddler classroom. The classroom has two sinks and two toilets and will serve children ages birth-30 months of age. The classroom measures 24 ft. x 36 ft.=864 square feet providing enough space to accommodate the maximum group size of 12 infants and toddlers birth-30 months of age.

The following rooms are approved child use space:

The toddler room measures 24 x 36 providing enough space for 17 children ages birth-30 months of age. The maximum group size for this classroom is 12.

The gym measures 24 x 29=696 square feet. The gym will be used during the day for gross motor activity space for all of the children in the center and for school age children in before and after school care. The gym has a total capacity of 20 school age children. The center understands that the maximum group size for each age group must be maintained at all times.

The nap room measures 34 x 24=816 square feet providing enough space for 23 preschool age children.

The preschool classroom will serve children ages 3-5 years old and measures

24 ft. x 35 ft.=840 square feet and provides enough space for 16 preschool age children.

The infant classroom will provide space for infants and toddlers ages birth through 30 months of age. The infant classroom measures 22 ft. x 37 ft.=814 square feet providing enough space for 16 infants and toddlers. The maximum group size for this age group is 12.

The front classroom called the napping room is approved space for napping. The room measures 19 x 12=228 and can accommodate 6 children.

The nursing room is also used for napping and measures 10 ft x 13 ft= 130 square feet providing enough space for 4 children.

The young Pre-K classroom will be used for children ages 3 years to 4 years and measures 37 ft. x 22 ft=814 square feet and provides enough space for 23 preschool age children.

The toddler one classroom measures 21 x 29=609 square feet providing enough space for twelve toddlers ages 12 months though 30 months.

The Preschool Classroom will be used for child care children ages 3 ½ years-5 years. The preschool classroom measures 37ft x 22 ft=814 square feet providing enough space for 23 preschool age children.

The center has 11 toilets and 13 sinks available for the child care children's use and enough to accommodate the requested capacity increase from 86 to 98.

V. Recommendation

I recommend approving additional use space and increasing capacity from 86-98
