The children in the room did not receive appropriate care after Child I provided care for them despite being only 7 years old. Child I picked up children as reported by CCSM6 and CCSM8. Child I held children as reported by CCSM6, CCSM8, and CCSM9. Child I fed Child	This has been corrected. The children will always receive appropriate care and supervision. Infant care will only be provided by age-appropriate child care staff members or volunteers. The 7 year old is no longer spending time in the infant room.	Corrected

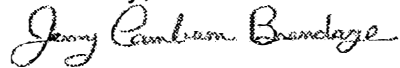
	A as reported by CCSM6 and Child A's Mother. Child I also was reported to have run and jumped over a child by CCSM8.		
R400.8173(4)	Child I, age 7 years old, was present in the Infant 2 room on a frequent basis for hours at a time. The Infant 2 room has play and learning equipment geared toward children ages 9 months to 18 months of age. The room did not contain play and learning equipment for school age children. Mr. Furrha does not intend to include school age children in the Infant 2 room.	This has been corrected. The children in care will have access to age-appropriate play and learning equipment. Each room is equipped with adequate play and learning equipment based on the approved age ranges in each room. The infant/young toddler room contains adequate play and learning equipment for this age group only. The 7 year old is no longer present for extended periods of time in the infant room.	Corrected
R400.8179(2)	Child I, age 7 years old, was present in the Infant 2 room on a frequent basis for hours at a time. The Infant 2 room provides educational programming geared toward children ages 9 months to 18 months. The room does not provide organized school-aged educational programming. Mr. Furrha does not intend to include school age children in the Infant 2 room.	This has been corrected. Each room will provide daily learning experiences appropriate to the developmental level and ages of children present in the room. The infant/young toddler room provides daily learning experiences appropriate to the developmental level of infants and young toddlers. The 7 year old is no longer present for extended periods of time in the infant room.	Corrected
