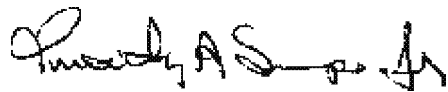

R400.8125(1) Staff, volunteer; responsibilities.	The center did not provide Child A with appropriate care and supervision on 1/23/23, when CCSM 1 and CCSM 2 left Child A unsupervised and alone in the fenced outdoor play area for approximately 15-19 minutes.	I, Ms. Paige Cadmus, licensee designee was found in non compliance of this licensing rule. I will assure the child care staff members provide the children with appropriate care and supervision at all times. On 1/23/23, Child A did not receive appropriate care and supervision. Child A was left alone on the fenced outdoor play area by himself without being directly supervised by a child care staff member. He was found sitting by the gate located in the outdoor	03/15/2023

		play area approximately 15-19 minutes after the children went inside. Child A was not harmed and remains in care at the center. Since the incident, I have spoken with all of the staff members to remind them of the importance of assuring the children are provided with appropriate care and supervision at all times. We have discussed the importance of conducting random head counts at all times of the day to include during busy transition times. In addition, each classroom was also given a name to face attendance form to use to document the child's time of arrival, and when they leave the room during transition time; the child care staff members are documenting the ratios on their classroom doors every hour. To take an additional step, the center has now posted a sign in/out sheet at every exit door on the lower level to document every child that is going outside. The child care staff members will now be using the GroupMe application to notify administration when they are leaving the classrooms during transition times. The administrators will monitor their children during transition time on iPad's to ensure the safety of the children during transition times. The two staff members involved in leaving Child A outside were terminated from employment at the center. This violation has been corrected and will be maintained at all times	
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R400.8170(9) Outdoor play area.	On 1/23/23, Child A was playing up in the treehouse platform climber while engaged in outdoor play which was not age appropriate for Child A as this play structure is designed for children ages 5 – 12 years old.	I, Ms. Paige Cadmus, licensee designee was found in non compliance of this licensing rule. I will assure the child care children only use age appropriate play equipment when engaged in outdoor play. I have reminded the child care staff members of the importance to assure the children do not use outdoor play equipment that is not designed for their age in order to assure for their safety as children of different ages differ dramatically not only in physical size and ability, but also in their cognitive and social skills. This violation has been corrected and will be maintained.	03/15/2023
