III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children's records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the inspection, the center was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

R 400.8134 Hand washing.

- (3) Staff and volunteers shall ensure that children wash their hands at all of the following times:**
(b) After toileting or diapering.

Staff did not wash children's hands after diapering in Toddler 1 and Toddler 2.

R 400.8152 Medication; administrative procedures.

- (4) Prescription medication must have the pharmacy label indicating the physician's name, child's first and last name, instructions, name and strength of the medication, and must be given according to those instructions.**

There were 5 epi-pens with no prescription label.

R 400.8315 Food and equipment storage.

- (1) Each refrigerator must have an accurate working thermometer indicating a temperature of 41 degrees Fahrenheit or below.**

The refrigerators in Infant 1 and Infant 2 did not have a thermometer.

R 400.8330 Food services and nutrition generally.

- (23) Children shall not have beverage containers or food while they are walking around or playing.**

Three children in Toddler 2 were walking around with cups and bottles.

A corrective action plan was requested and approved on 04/26/2022. It is expected that the corrective action plan be implemented within the specified time frames as outlined in the approved plan. A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a original license to this child care center.
