Dear Mrs. Mattea:

This letter is a follow-up to the Department's findings regarding the interim inspection conducted at your center on 10/24/2022. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with applicable licensing statutes and administrative rules for Child Care Centers.

During the onsite inspection, I observed all licensed classrooms to be clean and organized. There was no clutter of storage noted in any of them. All rooms were within ratio and teachers were properly engaging children. Consultation was provided on downloading a pdf copy of licensing rules.

The violations that were found are:

R 400.8131 Professional development requirements.

(12) When the department of licensing and regulatory affairs or the department of education publishes a notice that a new health and safety update document or a new health and safety update training activity has been published on MiRegistry, the licensee shall ensure that all personnel read and acknowledge the document or complete the activity within 6 month of the notice.

A review of MiRegistry indicated T, Maxwell, D. Taylor did not complete the 2020 and 2021 health and safety refresher. A Minter-Johnson did not complete the 2020 refresher.

Due to the violations, you must send us a corrective action plan by 11/13/2022. You can use our [corrective action plan](#) form or create your own.

If you need help writing the corrective action plan, please contact me. If you do not send a corrective action plan, you may face disciplinary action. The corrective action plan must include the following:

- How compliance with each rule will be achieved.
- Who is directly responsible for implementing the corrective action for each violation.
- Specific time frames for each violation as to when the correction will be completed or implemented.
- How continuing compliance will be maintained once compliance is achieved.
- The signature of the responsible party and a date.

Upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, there will be no change to your license status.

Technical Assistance: The district is aware the health and safety trainings are a federal mandate and must be completed as outlined by licensing rules.
