II. Purpose of Addendum

On 06/18/2023, the request for modification of the terms of the license was received. The licensee designee, Amanda Mattea, requested a change in use space. She requested to add rooms 105, 109, 110, 112, and gym as approved child use space. The capacity of the center's license will change from 60 children to 72 children.

III. Methodology

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

The terms of the original license have been modified on September 1, 2023.

The following rooms were previously approved for child care:

- Room 117 measures 31.0 ft. x 22 ft., providing approximately 682 square feet and the adjoining large muscle playroom measures 22.0 ft. x 13 ft., providing 286 square feet and can accommodate 28 children, ages 2 ½ to 5 years, based on 35 square feet per child. The center requested a capacity of 20 children for this room.

The following room will be changed or added as approved child use space:

- Rooms 117 will no longer be used and removed as approved child use space.
- Room 105 measures 21.6 ft. x 30.1 ft., providing approximately 650 square feet and can accommodate 18 children, ages 3 to 5 years, based on 35 square feet per child. The center is requesting a capacity of 18 children for this room.
- Room 109 measures 33.0 ft. x 21.1 ft., providing approximately 693 square feet and can accommodate 19 children, ages 3 to 5 years, based on 35 square feet per child. The center is requesting a capacity of 18 children for this room.
- Room 110 measures 23.3 ft. x 27.10 ft., providing approximately 631 square feet and can accommodate 18 children, ages 3 to 5 years, based on 35 square feet per child. The center is requesting a capacity of 18 children for this room.
- Room 112 measures 37.7 ft. x 23.3 ft., providing approximately 878 square feet and can accommodate 25 children, ages 3 to 5 years, based on 35

square feet per child. The center is requesting a capacity of 18 children for this room.

- Gym measures 87.1 ft. x 67.11 ft., providing approximately 5845 square feet and can accommodate 167 children, ages 3 to 5 years, based on 35 square feet per child. The gym is approved as additional child use space but is not used to determine the center's total capacity.

The approved capacity is 72 children at any one time, ages 3 to 5 years. There is a total of six hand washing sinks, four urinals, and 12 toilets. This supports the center's requested capacity.

The rooms are furnished with a variety of developmentally appropriate equipment. An equipment list is on file.

New inspections were completed to add additional child use space. The certification of school building fire safety provisions was completed on 01/10/2023. The environmental health inspection was completed on 07/05/2023. The lead hazard risk assessment was completed on 08/31/2023.

Terms:

The center is approved for a total capacity of 72 children, ages 3 to 5 years. The center has a licensed kitchen and provide daily food services. Breakfast, lunch, and snack is offered each day.

V. Recommendation

I recommend the change of use space to add rooms 105, 109, 110, 112, gym, and increase in the center's capacity. The center's capacity of the license will change from 60 to 72 children, ages 3 to 5 years.
