III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children's records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the onsite inspection, I observed the overall facility to be very clean. Pre-K rooms were organized and had sufficient amounts of equipment for children's use. Staff were exceptionally pleasant, organized and providing appropriate care and supervision to the children. Required records were onsite and appropriately maintained.

During the inspection, the center was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

R 400.8173

Equipment.

(4) Play equipment, materials, and furniture, must be all of the following:

(b) Safe, clean, and in good repair.

The large area rug in room 123 is worn, dirty and stained with an unknown substance. Please replace.

R 400.8380

Maintenance of premises.

(4) Floors, interior walls, and ceilings must be kept in sound condition, good repair, and maintained in a clean condition.

The boy's bathroom has an opening in the wall with exposed plumbing fixtures. The area is easily accessible to children. Please repair immediately.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

Upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, I recommend issuance of a regular license to the facility.
