IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

Room 109 measures approximately 25 ft x 28 ft totaling 700 square feet and can accommodate up to 20 children age 4.

There are four toilets and three handwashing sinks for the children to use. There is an adequate amount of age and developmentally equipment on site

This GSRP program will operate Monday – Thursday from 8:35 am to 3:20 pm. This is a full-time full day program.

The program will serve breakfast, lunch and a snack.

Swimming and transportation are not components of this program.

The children will used the fenced early childhood playground. A playground inspection was completed 12/15/2009 by Daniel Trybuski (14272-0512)

An environmental Health inspection was completed 9/21/2022.

A lead hazard risk assessment was completed 9/26/2022 by Alan Hill P-07070)

V. Recommendation

I recommend classroom 109 be added to the license and the capacity be increased to 53 children ages 3-12
