II. Purpose of Addendum

On 08/02/2022, the licensee designee Dijani Dagle requested the adding of one classroom, 104. Several previously classrooms, 100 and 101, are closed. The capacity will be decreased from 48 to 36

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

The terms of the original license were modified on 06/11/2008.

The following spaces are currently approved:.

New approved spaces:

Room 104 and 106 independently measure 38' x 22' providing a total square foot of 836. Each room can accommodate a capacity of 24 children, but the space will be used for 18 children, ages 4 to 5 for preschool programming.

There is an adequate and varied amount of age-appropriate equipment and materials available in each room.

On 08/01/2022, I inspected the over 2400 square foot Gym. It was clean and did not present with obvious safety hazards, but a health and lead inspection is needed before final approval is granted. Once all inspections have been submitted, with an "A" rating, it may be used for gross motor activity only. The facility will be notified when the area is approved.

The facility has a total of 4 toilets and 4 sinks which supports the capacity.

Food service will continue to be provided by the licensed onsite kitchen.

The district is hiring staff for the new space and will forward an updated spreadsheet of all directors by the second week of the school year. It is understood no person will be of staff without proper credentials and child care fingerprints on file.

V. Recommendation

I recommend the addition of rooms 104 and 106 with an approved capacity of 36.
