

III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children's records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

On 11/17/2022 during an onsite inspection I was able to visit all classrooms. In the infant room I observed a diaper change as well as multiple feedings. Infants who were sleeping were supervised and infants who were awake were engaged in multiple activities with their primary caregivers. In the toddler rooms, staff were engaged with the children as they played with various activities. In the prek classroom, the children were participating in group time and then transitioned over to the table to work on a task involving counting. In the discovery room, children were arriving from outside, washing

up and then playing with different materials such as puzzles, magnet tiles and cutting with scissors. In the preschool room students were playing freely with various materials such as puzzles, and paint. They then transitioned to cleaning up and getting ready to head outside. All child care staff members were engaged with the children.

During the inspection, the center was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

R 400.8112 Comprehensive background check; fingerprinting.

- (2) An applicant or licensee shall do all of the following:**
 - (e) Within the department's child care background check system, accurately complete and maintain the connection, disconnection, or withdrawn status of each individual associated with the license.**

On 11/17/2022, There were five staff members not connected on CCBC who currently work at the facility. There were two staff members connected who no longer worked at the facility and their were two individuals eligible but not connected or disconnected.

R 400.8131 Professional development requirements.

- (12) When the department of licensing and regulatory affairs or the department of education publishes a notice that a new health and safety update document or a new health and safety update training activity has been published on MiRegistry, the licensee shall ensure that all personnel read and acknowledge the document or complete the activity within 6 month of the notice.**

On 11/17/2022 six out of the six staff member records that were reviewed were missing the 2021 health and safety refresher course.
