## **II. Purpose of Addendum**

Dana Jones, the licensee designee request to modify the license to include a GSRP classroom and increase the capacity by 18.

Margaret Kaczmerek, the licensee requested to modify the license to add a four year old space in Classroom 2 at Isbister. The licensing capacity will increase the accommodate 18 four year olds.

## **IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions**

The terms of the original license were modified September 6, 2022.

The new GSRP classroom will be located in room 19 which measures 26 ft. x 29 ft. totaling 754 square feet and can accommodate up to 21 children ages four to five. The licensee request a capacity of 16 children.

There is one toilet and 2 sinks in the classroom. There are additional toilets and sinks located in the hallway.

This is a full-time school day program open Monday -Thursday. Lunch and 2 snacks will be served.

There is ample age and developmentally appropriate equipment for the children. there is a fenced play area adjacent to the building.

In 2015 a request was made for a preschool and approved but the preschool did not open.

There is an approved before and after school program operating in the building under the same license. The capacity will not change.

The facility is adding a preschool program for child age four years. The program will operate from Room 2. The room measures 25'x28' for a total of 700 square feet and can accommodate up to 20 children allowing at least 35 square feet for each child.

The room has a bathroom with one toilet and one sink. This is sufficient to accommodate the requested capacity of 18.

The center has sufficient developmentally appropriate equipment to accommodate the capacity.


A lead inspection was completed and the facility was approved on September 21, 2022.

An approved environmental health inspection was provided dated August 25, 2015.

Rachel Stewart will be the preschool program director. Ms. Stewart was previously Approved under rule 8113(7)(a) and (9).

I recommend the additional of a preschool program in Room 19 at Isbister.
