Findings of the Inspection

The purpose of the Interim inspection was to determine compliance with applicable licensing statutes and administrative rules for child care Center.

During the Interim inspection, licensing consultant Laura Piacentini found 4 violations. The violations are listed and explained below. - How compliance with each rule will be achieved.
- Who is directly responsible for implementing the corrective action for each violation.
- Specific time frames for each violation as to when the correction will be completed or implemented.
- How continuing compliance will be maintained once compliance is achieved.
- The signature of the responsible party and a date.

Due to the health and safety professional development training violation(s), all of the facility’s child care staff members must complete the required training by 1/26/2024. This must be included in the facility’s corrective action plan.
