III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center’s records, including staff records and children’s records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children’s records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the inspection, the center was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

R 400.8131 Professional development requirements.

(11) Verification of all professional development required by this rule must be kept on file at the center or online at MiRegistry. Verification must be issued from the training organization or trainer and include the date of the course, the name of the training organization or trainer, the topic covered, and the number of clock hours. Training hours from MiRegistry also meet this rule.

Six of ten child care staff members did not have verification of professional development training on file at the center or MiRegistry.

R 400.8176 Sleeping equipment.

(17) When sleeping equipment and bedding are stored, both of the following apply:
(b) Bedding must not come into contact with other bedding.

The bedding on the cots in the toddler room were stacked and touching.

Consultation was provided regarding recall list, relocating crisis management plans, adding more developmentally appropriate books to the classrooms and removing torn books, move cleaning products to cabinets.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

Upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care center.
