R 400.8110(3)(c)	A notice stating that the center requires a comprehensive background check on its employees and unsupervised volunteers.
R 400.8330(10)	Menus must be planned in advance, dated, and posted in a place visible to parents. Food substitutions must be noted on the menus the day the substitution occurs.
R 400.8176(1)	All bedding and sleeping equipment must be appropriate for the child, clean, comfortable, safe, and in good repair.
R 400.8143(2)	Child information cards must be reviewed and updated by parents at least annually and when the center becomes aware of changes.

R 400.8535(2)	In centers of more than 4 child-occupied rooms, excluding bathrooms, or in centers licensed for more than 60 children, an approved fire alarm system shall be installed and maintained in compliance with NFPA(7)2.
R 400.8320(1)	Food must be in sound condition, free from spoilage, filth, or other contamination and be safe for human consumption.
