

**III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS**

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center’s records, including staff records and children’s records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children’s records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the onsite inspection I observed five rooms. The toddler classroom had free choice time and engaged in blocks at the table. In the infant classroom, they engaged in tummy time. The child care staff members sang to the infants. The GSRP classroom had worktime. They explored with clay, bingo markers, and looked at shells for science. The preschool class said nursery rhymes, worked on puzzles, and build with blocks. There were also children having computer time. I also visited
