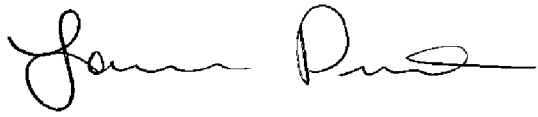

III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children's records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

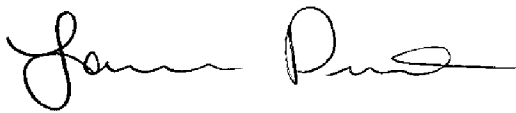
On 1/11/2023, During an onsite inspection, I observed all nine classrooms. Two of the toddler classrooms were outside playing on the playground. After playing outside, children came inside and were able to explore the classroom freely. Children were

playing with various equipment such as large wooden lacing beads, blocks, animals, trains and musical instruments. I observed snack time in the third toddler classroom as well as diaper changes. In the preschool classrooms I was able to observed a little bit of classroom exploration time where children explore the classroom and materials freely. Some children were working together in building and playing with a ramp. Others were exploring pain, legos, dinosaurs, puzzles, and blocks. I observed story read aloud in two preschool classrooms as well as Lunch time in one of the GSRP classrooms. All staff members were interacting with children appropriately. They encouraged children to use their words, communicate and work with peers as well as encouraged doing things like putting on coats and shoes independently.

Technical assistance was provided regarding getting the centers serious accident or injury plan posted in classrooms as well as posting their notice of background check.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this childcare center.
