

**III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS**

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center’s records, including staff records and children’s records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children’s records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the onsite inspection, there were 22 children present. The children had to draw where they wanted to play for free time. Some preschoolers chose the art table, kitchen area, or sand table. Others chose floor play, blocks or Legos. They had chicken nuggets, baby carrots, chilled peaches, cheese crackers, and milk for lunch.

During the inspection, the center was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:


**R 400.8112 (2)(e)** Comprehensive background check; fingerprinting.

**(2) An applicant or licensee shall do all of the following:  
(e) Within the department's child care background check system, accurately complete and maintain the connection, disconnection, or withdrawn status of each individual associated with the license.**

During the onsite inspection, there was an employee who was connected in the child care background check system who was not on staff.

#### IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care facility.
