

III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center’s records, including staff records and children’s records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children’s records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.


During the onsite inspection on 11/23/2020, I observed children learning through High Scope Curriculum. The center has instituted virtual learning for the children who are learning remotely. The toddlers reviewed the number 12 and practiced the letter L. They also reviewed colors associated with color words and pictures. The children ate pasta, broccoli, tropical fruit, crackers, and milk. Technical Assistance was

provided regarding the use of the department's form for the written packet informing parents of the center's handbook. A copy of the form was emailed to Ms. Moye, the program director. Consultation was provided to both the licensee designee and the program director regarding staying abreast of the rules by reviewing the center rule book.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care center.
