This letter is a follow-up to the Department's findings regarding the interim inspection conducted at your center on 06/09/2022. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with applicable licensing statutes and administrative rules for Child Care Centers.

During the onsite inspection, there were nine children present. The children were watching a dance video where they danced to it. The classroom was being packed up because the last day of school is 06/10/2022. A check of emergency procedures will be checked at the renewal inspection.

The violations that were found are:

R 400.8112 Comprehensive background check; fingerprinting.

- (2) An applicant or licensee shall do all of the following:
 - (e) Within the department's child care background check system, accurately complete and maintain the connection, disconnection, or withdrawn status of each individual associated with the license.

During the onsite inspection, there were four individuals who were connected to the license in the child care background check system that were no longer employed.

Information provided to parents.

(2) Written documentation that the parent received the written information packet, as required by subrule (1) of this rule, must be kept on file at the center.

During the onsite inspection, there were no signed documents by the parents to verify they had received the written information packet.

Electrical service.

(5) All electrical outlets in child use areas for children who are not yet school-age shall be made inaccessible to children.

During the onsite inspection, there were six outlets missing safety covers.

On 06/06/2022, you gave us an acceptable written corrective action plan.

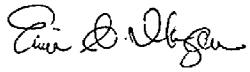
