Dear Ms. Campbell:

This letter is a follow-up to the Department's findings regarding the interim inspection conducted at your center on 12/13/2021. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with applicable licensing statutes and administrative rules for Child Care Centers.

The violations that were found are:

**R 400.8158 Incident, accident, injury, illness, death, fire reporting.**

(2) A licensee, licensee designee, or program director shall report to the child's parent and the department, directly or via phone, fax, or email, within 24 hours of the occurrence of any of the following:

(c) A fire on the premises of the center that requires the use of fire suppression equipment or results in loss of life or property.

On 12/13/2021, I attempted an interim inspection at the center. The windows were busted out and partially boarded up. There was a pad lock on the door. The outdoor play area and fenced in parking lot were in disrepair.

On 12/14/2021, I emailed with licensee designee, Roxanne Campbell. She indicated they are not using that building at this time because there was a building fire in July 2021. The department was not notified within 24 hours of the fire.

Due to the violations, you must send us a corrective action plan by 12/29/2021. You can use our [corrective action plan](#) form or create your own.

If you need help writing the corrective action plan, please contact me. If you do not send a corrective action plan, you may face disciplinary action. The corrective action plan must include the following:

- How compliance with each rule will be achieved.
- Who is directly responsible for implementing the corrective action for each violation.
- Specific time frames for each violation as to when the correction will be completed or implemented.
- How continuing compliance will be maintained once compliance is achieved.
- The signature of the responsible party and a date.

Upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, there will be no change to your license status. Children may not be cared for in the building until it has been restored and has passed all inspections.
