IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

The terms of the original license have been modified on 11/02/2017, 11/20/2020, and 2/21/2023. The previously approved rooms are below:

Room 104 which measures at 27 ft. x 35 ft. providing a total of 945 square feet. This can accommodate up to 27 children ages 2 ½ and older. This supports the centers request of 18 children.

Room 106 which measures at 27 ft. x 29 ft. and 4 ft. x 20 ft. providing a total of 863 square feet. This can accommodate up to 25 children ages 2 ½ and older. This supports the centers request of 18 children

Room 108 which measures at 34 ft. x 25.5 ft. providing a total of 867 square feet. This can accommodate up to 25 children ages 2 ½ and older. This supports the centers request of 18 children.

Room 118 which measures at 27 ft. x 35 ft. providing a total of 945 square feet. This can accommodate up to 27 children ages 2 ½ and older. This supports the centers request of 18 children.

In room 104 there is a bathroom with one sink and one toilet. In room 108 there is a toilet and two sinks. In room 118 there is one handwashing sink and a bathroom that contains one toilet and one handwashing sink.

Down the hallway is a both a boy's and a girls restroom. The boys' bathroom has two toilets, one urinal and three sinks. The girls' bathroom includes three toilets and two sinks.


All classrooms are furnished with a variety of developmentally appropriate equipment.

Terms:

The center is approved for a total capacity of 72 children ages 3 ½ - 5 years of age. The program is approved for food services and transportation.

V. Recommendation

I recommend approval for the center to add transportation component to their license. The centers capacity is 72 children ages 3 ½-5 years of age.
