Dear Ms. Anderson-Reeves:

This letter is a follow-up to the Department's findings regarding the interim inspection conducted at your center on 05/10/2023. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with applicable licensing statutes and administrative rules for Child Care Centers.

The violations that were found are:

R 400.8131 Professional development requirements.

(12) When the department of licensing and regulatory affairs or the department of education publishes a notice that a new health and safety update document or a new health and safety update training activity has been published on MiRegistry, the licensee shall ensure that all personnel read and acknowledge the document or complete the activity within 6 month of the notice.

On 05/10/2023, the Program Director and one child care staff member were missing the 2022 health and safety refresher trainings on MiResgistry.

R 400.8131 Professional development requirements.

(5) Within 90 days of being hired, or the first day as an unsupervised volunteer, all child care staff members and unsupervised volunteers who work directly with children shall complete the following trainings, which may count toward annual professional development hours and are available at MiRegistry:

- (a) Administration of medication.
- (b) Prevention of and response to emergencies due to food and allergic reactions.
- (c) Building and physical premises safety.
- (d) Emergency preparedness and response planning.
- (e) Handling and storage of hazardous materials and appropriate disposal of bio-contaminants.
- (f) Precautions in transporting children, if applicable.
- (g) Child development.

On 05/10/2023, three child care staff members were missing trainings in the Administration of medication, Prevention of and response to emergencies due to food and allergic reactions, Building and physical premises safety, Emergency preparedness and response planning, and the Handling and storage of hazardous materials and appropriate disposal of bio contaminants These training is included in the MiRegistry Health and Safety Course 1 and Course 2

On 05/10/2023, you gave us an acceptable written corrective action plan. There will be no change to your license status.

On 05/10/2023, during my onsite inspection, I observed all three classrooms. In one classroom, children were engaged in small group time where children were planting seeds. They then transitioned over to work time where children got to play freely around the classroom. In the other two classrooms, I observed children engaged in lunch time. Children were encouraged to try their as they had quiet conversations with children at their table.

Technical assistance was provided regarding child information cards and making sure that the cards are filled out completely. This includes the date of admission box and the allergy information sections. In the fall, they will switch to the new edition of child information cards. Technical assistance was also provided regarding making sure that tables are washed before mealtime.
