III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center’s records, including staff records and children’s records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children’s records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the inspection, the center was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

R 400.8131 Professional development requirements.

(12) When the department of licensing and regulatory affairs or the department of education publishes a notice that a new health and safety update document or a new health and safety update training activity has been published on MiRegistry, the licensee shall ensure that all personnel read and acknowledge the document or complete the activity within 6 month of the notice.

Four of nine staff were missing health and safety refresher 2021, health and safety course 1 and/or 2.

Consultation was provided regarding date on milk once open, dish pan to sanitize dishes when dishwasher is not used, label bulk snacks in canisters, post menu in lobby and remove items behind shed in outdoor play area.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

Upon receipt of an "A" rated fire inspection report and approved corrective action plan, I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care facility.
