Dear Ms Obad:

This letter is a follow-up to the Department's findings regarding the interim inspection conducted at your center on 02/13/2023. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with applicable licensing statutes and administrative rules for Child Care Centers.

During the onsite inspection I observed children doing homework being tutored and watching a video. I observed positive child/care giver interactions. I provided consultation on stained ceiling tiles in rooms.

The violations that were found are:

R 400.8131 Professional development requirements.

(12) When the department of licensing and regulatory affairs or the department of education publishes a notice that a new health and safety update document or a new health and safety update training activity has been published on MiRegistry, the licensee shall ensure that all personnel read and acknowledge the document or complete the activity within 6 month of the notice.

During the onsite inspection on 02/13/2023, one out of five staff files reviewed had a staff member who had not completed the health and safety refresher for 2022.

R 400.8143 Children's records.

(1) At the time of a child's initial attendance, a center shall obtain a child information card, using a form provided by the department or a comparable substitute, that is completed and signed by the child's parent. The center shall keep it on file and accessible in the center.

During the onsite inspection on 02/13/2023, two out of ten child information cards reviewed were not signed.

Due to the violations, you must send us a corrective action plan by 03/06/2023. You can use our corrective action plan form or create your own. If you need help writing the corrective action plan, please contact me. If you do not send a corrective action plan, you may face disciplinary action. The corrective action plan must include the following:

- How compliance with each rule will be achieved.
- Who is directly responsible for implementing the corrective action for each violation.
- Specific time frames for each violation as to when the correction will be completed or implemented.
- How continuing compliance will be maintained once compliance is achieved.
- The signature of the responsible party and a date.

Upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, there will be no change to your license status.
