This letter is a follow-up to the Department's findings regarding the interim inspection conducted at your center on 04/19/2022. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with applicable licensing statutes and administrative rules for Child Care Centers.

During the onsite inspection on 04/19/2022 there were 11 toddlers present. The toddlers identified their colors by plastic-colored bears. Each toddler had their own color. The child care staff members had the toddlers identify the color of bears they had. They also engaged in building blocks. There were 12 preschoolers present. The preschoolers exercised to music, worked on puzzles, and heard a story. Technical Assistance was provided regarding ensuring new staff are aware of the diapering and handwashing practices according to the licensing rules.

The violations that were found are:

R 400.8161

Emergency procedures.

(1) Written procedures for the care of children and staff for each of the following emergencies must be developed and implemented:

(e) Crisis management including, but not limited to, intruders, active shooters, bomb threats, and other man-made events.

During the onsite inspection on 04/19/2022 there was no Crisis Management Plan developed or on site that is accessible to all personnel.

Due to the violations, you must send us a corrective action plan by 05/11/2022. You can use our [corrective action plan](#) form or create your own.

If you need help writing the corrective action plan, please contact me. If you do not send a corrective action plan, you may face disciplinary action. The corrective action plan must include the following:

- How compliance with each rule will be achieved.
- Who is directly responsible for implementing the corrective action for each violation.
- Specific time frames for each violation as to when the correction will be completed or implemented.
- How continuing compliance will be maintained once compliance is achieved.
- The signature of the responsible party and a date.

Upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, there will be no change to your license status.


