


III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children's records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the onsite inspection I arrived before lunch time. The children heard stories in both in the toddler class, and in the preschool class. The children ate broccoli, beans, sliced hotdogs, peaches and milk. Technical Assistance was provided to program director, Shawndrea Oliver regarding ensuring that all reports are filed in the licensing notebook.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.
