III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children's records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.


On 3/23/2023, during an onsite inspection, I observed both classrooms. I was able to observe small group time in both classrooms. In 100, students were drawing pictures of how they could make someone happy at one table. At the other table they were experimenting with ice cubes and talking about what happens when ice melts. The classroom then transitioned to planning time where children planned what they wanted to work on that day and then were able to explore the room freely. In 102 children were painting with ice cubes at one table and at the other table children

were gluing tissue paper into different patterns. Children then transitioned to planning time and then work time where they were able to explore the room freely.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care center.
