Dear Ms. McClain:

This letter is a follow-up to the Department's findings regarding the interim inspection conducted at your center on 11/10/2022. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with applicable licensing statutes and administrative rules for Child Care Centers.

The violations that were found are:

R 400.8112 Comprehensive background check; fingerprinting.

- (2) An applicant or licensee shall do all of the following:
 - (e) Within the department's child care background check system, accurately complete and maintain the connection, disconnection, or withdrawn status of each individual associated with the license.

On 11/10/2022 there were 23 individuals connected to CCBC including 13 childcare staff members, eight unsupervised volunteers and one Licensee Designee. There is currently only one childcare staff member on site.

R 400.8131 Professional development requirements.

(12) When the department of licensing and regulatory affairs or the department of education publishes a notice that a new health and safety update document or a new health and safety update training activity has been published on MiRegistry, the licensee shall ensure that all personnel read and acknowledge the document or complete the activity within 6 month of the notice.

On 11/10/2022, one child care staff member was missing the 2021 health and safety refresher course. She stated she enrolled in the course but never completed it.

On 11/10/2022, during an onsite inspection I observed one child care staff member with 13 students present. students who were tired got to rest on a yoga mat on the floor while others completed homework, played games or socialized. After free time students cleaned up their stuff to read the rules and expectations of the program together. Students then went to the bathroom to wash up for snack. After snack students engaged in a word builder game as well as had a discussion on bullying.

Due to the violations, you must send us a corrective action plan by 12/06/2022. You can use our [corrective action plan](#) form or create your own.

If you need help writing the corrective action plan, please contact me. If you do not send a corrective action plan, you may face disciplinary action. The corrective action plan must include the following:

- How compliance with each rule will be achieved.
- Who is directly responsible for implementing the corrective action for each violation.
- Specific time frames for each violation as to when the correction will be completed or implemented.
- How continuing compliance will be maintained once compliance is achieved.
- The signature of the responsible party and a date.


