This letter is to advise you that the 11/01/2022 corrective action plan you submitted, regarding each rule violation cited in the recently completed Special Investigation Report, is approved.

Christian Newby is prohibited from being on the premises of the child care center, but has been confirmed by CCSM, Audrey Newby that Christian barely comes to the center and if she does it is to say hello. She has delivered food through Door dash or Uber eats and left the food in the parking lot.	Licensee has ensured that known felons will not be allowed on the premises of the child care center.	Effective immediately

R 400.8112(4)(b) Comprehensive background check; fingerprinting.	Based on the interviews conducted with complainant and Child F and G's Mother confirmed Christian Newby was working in the center having contact with the children in care. Christian's schedule varied she worked in the morning or the afternoon. Darlissha Newby has been made aware by three consultants during three separate special investigations Christian Newby is not allowed on the premises. She was found ineligible 6/19/2019 but continued to volunteer at the center both supervised and unsupervised.	Known felons will not be allowed to volunteer or be employed at the center.	Effective immediately
R 400.8146(3)(c) Information provided to parents.	The staff in the infant room does not provide a written daily record that includes elimination patterns, including bowel movements, consistency, and frequency.	Licensee has ensured that infant staff will start providing a written daily record for families and children with special needs.	Effective immediately
R 400.8176(17)(b) Sleeping equipment.	I observed bedding that was in contact with other bedding, piled on top of cots.	Licensee has ensured that bedding will not come in contact with each other by storing them in bags or folded completely on their cots.	Effective immediately
R 400.8330(14) Food services and nutrition generally.	I observed a CCSM warm a bottle in the microwave oven which is prohibited.	Licensee has ensured that bottles will no longer be warmed in the microwave.	Effective immediately

It is expected that the corrective action plan will be implemented within the time frames as outlined in your plan.

A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.
