

III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS


This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children's records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the onsite inspection on 8/11/2021 there were 23 children present. Mrs. Stokes has a virtual learning program for school age children. The preschoolers practiced their fine motor skills and their names. The children went on a walk with two child care staff members. The children ate apples, goldfish crackers, and juice for snack. Mrs. Stokes has a wealth of age-appropriate equipment for her children in care. Consultation was provided regarding the organization of the children's files.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this childcare center.
