**III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS**

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center’s records, including staff records and children’s records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children’s records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

During the onsite inspection, I observed 2 GSRP spaces and an older toddler area. Children were observed engaging in learning activities, handwashing and some were eating breakfast. The facility was clean, well organized and had an adequate amount of play and learning equipment. Staff were engaged with the children and the facility was within ratio.

Technical assistance/ consultation provided on 2020 health and safety refresher for Mrs. Barriera-Manrique. She must also be listed in CCBC as a program director.

MICR IP-101 reports should adequately reflect the number of children enrolled and immunizations must be current.

#### IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend the issuance of a regular license to this childcare center.
