

## III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children's records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the onsite inspection on 04/19/2022, there were 11 toddlers present. They identified colors using plastic fruit. They also engaged in gross motor activity using building blocks. The preschoolers participated in exercises, puzzles and they listened to a story. Technical Assistance was provided regarding updating the Crisis Management plan.

During the inspection, the center was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statues except for the following violations:

**R 400.8305                    Plan review; approval; inspections.**

**(2) An inspection must be conducted by the local health department, and an approval granted indicating compliance with all of the rules in this part, except R 400.8330, 400.8335, and 400.8340, at all of the following times:**

**(c) Every 2 years, at the time of renewal, if the center provides food service where the food is prepared and served on-site, unless the kitchen is currently licensed to provide food service.**

During the onsite inspection on 04/19/2022 the fire safety inspection on file was dated for 06/13/2019. By renewing Mrs. White, this fire would not be good for the duration of her license. A fire safety inspection was conducted on 04/25/2022. A current fire safety inspection is on file at the center.

**R 400.8510                    Plans and specifications; submission; approval; inspections.**


**(3) A fire safety inspection shall be conducted by the bureau of fire services or a department-approved qualified fire inspector, and an approval granted, before issuance of the original license and every 4 years thereafter, at the time of renewal.**

During the onsite inspection on 04/19/2022 the environment health inspection on file was dated for 09/05/2018. An environmental health inspection was conducted on 05/18/2022. A current environmental health inspection is on file at the center.

A corrective action plan was requested and approved on 04/19/2022. It is expected that the corrective action plan be implemented within the specified time frames as outlined in the approved plan. A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.

#### IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care center.
