## III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children's records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

During the onsite inspection, children were observed to be engaged in age-appropriate activities. Children participated outdoor and indoor activities. Staff were observed to be

properly supervising children during all activities and using proper transitional techniques when moving from one area to the next. Children were observed during lunch as well. Positive caregiver and child interactions was also observed during the onsite.

During the exit conference technical assistance was provided to the licensee designee.

They were told to provide staff with a key or access card to the playground in efforts to prevent children from walking through the parking lot to regain entry into the building.

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care facility.
