This letter is a follow-up to the Department's findings regarding the interim inspection conducted at your center on 03/01/2023. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with applicable licensing statutes and administrative rules for Child Care Centers.

The violations that were found are:

R 400.8143 Children's records.

(1) At the time of a child's initial attendance, a center shall obtain a child information card, using a form provided by the department or a comparable substitute, that is completed and signed by the child's parent. The center shall keep it on file and accessible in the center.

During the onsite inspection on 03/01/2023, three out of ten child information records reviewed were missing information such as the parents contact number, emergency release last name, child's date of birth, and date signed

R 400.8143 Children's records.

(8) Upon enrollment and annually thereafter, a center shall obtain and keep on file at the center a signed statement from a school-age child's parent confirming all of the following:
(b) The child's immunizations are up-to-date.

During the onsite inspection on 03/01/2023, two out of ten children's records reviewed were not marked for whether the child's immunizations were up to date.

Due to the violations, you must send us a corrective action plan by 03/22/2023. You can use our corrective action plan form or create your own. If you need help writing the corrective action plan, please contact me. If you do not send a corrective action plan, you may face disciplinary action. The corrective action plan must include the following:

- How compliance with each rule will be achieved.
- Who is directly responsible for implementing the corrective action for each violation.
- Specific time frames for each violation as to when the correction will be completed or implemented.
- How continuing compliance will be maintained once compliance is achieved.
- The signature of the responsible party and a date.

Upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, there will be no change to your license status.

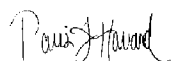
