

## III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children's records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the onsite inspection, there were five infants present. The infants engaged in tummy time and ate their lunch in highchairs. In the toddler classroom, there were five children present. They played with plastic fruit and other dramatic play items. They also had free choice time. The preschool classroom heard a story and cleaned up to a "clean up" song. The children ate blueberries, bagels and cream cheese and milk for lunch. Technical Assistance was provided regarding ensuring all emergency

records were complete as well as identifying all requirements of the crisis management plan.

During the inspection, the center was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statues except for the following violations:

**R 400.8112 (2)(e) Comprehensive background check; fingerprinting.**

**(2) An applicant or licensee shall do all of the following:  
(e) Within the department's child care background check system, accurately complete and maintain the connection, disconnection, or withdrawn status of each individual associated with the license.**

During the onsite inspection, Mrs. Veronica was not connected as the licensee designee and former employees were still in the ccbc system.

**R 400.8128 Staff; volunteer; tuberculosis.**

**A center shall keep on file at the center evidence to verify that each child care staff member and each volunteer who has contact with children at least 4 hours per week for more than 2 consecutive weeks is free from communicable tuberculosis (TB). Verification of TB status is required within 1 year before employment or volunteering.**

During the onsite inspection, there were staff who did not have a medical clearance with TB on file at the center.


**R 400.8335(8)(a) Food service and nutrition; provided by center.**

**All of the following apply to milk:  
(a) Containers must be labeled with the date opened.**

During the onsite inspection, there was open milk that did not have the date of opening labeled on it.

**IV. RECOMMENDATION**

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care center.
