- How compliance with each rule will be achieved.
- Who is directly responsible for implementing the corrective action for each violation.
- Specific time frames for each violation as to when the correction will be completed or implemented.
- How continuing compliance will be maintained once compliance is achieved.
- The signature of the responsible party and a date.

On 6/13/2024, an onsite inspection was completed at Nation of Wonders Inclusive Education, there were 12 children present. The children were observed to participate in painting, interactive sing-a-longs, imaginative play, and reading. The children were provided a well balanced lunch. The child care staff members were attentive to the children receiving care at the center.
