

III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children's records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the onsite inspection, I did not see the program due to the time I arrived. Erika Ahmad, program director said the children worked on sorting and they played an I Spy game by unwrapping aluminum foil to discover different items.

During the inspection, the center was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

R 400.8125 Staff; volunteer; requirements.

(1) All staff and volunteers shall provide appropriate care and supervision of children at all times.

During the onsite inspection, I observed that the center did not provide appropriate care and supervision during naptime. There was one staff present upon arrival with eight children present; 5 children were sleeping, and 3 children were awake. Two of the three children who were awake were under 2 ½ so the children were not properly supervised.

R 400.8143 Children's records.

(4) When a child under school-age whose immunizations were not up-to-date at the time of enrollment has been in attendance for 4 months, an updated certificate showing completion of all additional immunization requirements as specified by DHHS must be kept on file, unless there is a signed statement by a licensed health care provider stating immunizations are in progress.

The center has not been reporting immunization records to MDHHS. They did not have a certificate, (MCIR Report) showing completion of all required immunizations specified by Michigan Department of Health and Human Services on file at the center.

R 400.8182 Ratio and group size requirements.

(3) In each room or well-defined space, the maximum group size and ratio of child care staff members to children, including children related to a staff member or the licensee, must be as shown in Table 4:

	Age	Child Care Staff Member to Child Ratio	Maximum Group Size
(a)	Infants and toddlers, birth until 30 months of age	1 to 4	12
(b)	Preschoolers, 30 months of age until 3 years of age	1 to 8	16
(c)	Preschoolers, 3 years of age until 4 years of age	1 to 10	30
(d)	Preschoolers, 4 years of age until school-age	1 to 12	36
(e)	School-agers	1 to 18	36

During the onsite inspection, the center was out of ratio due to there being only one staff member present at naptime, when there were children under 2 ½ who were awake.


There were eight children present and one staff member present.

The correct ratio for children 2 ½ and under is 1:4, therefore, there should have been two staff present with eight children.

A corrective action plan was requested and approved on 03/20/2023. It is expected that the corrective action plan be implemented within the specified time frames as outlined in the approved plan. A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care center.
