III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children's records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the inspection, the center was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

R 400.8182

Ratio and group size requirements.

(7) If there are children of mixed ages in the same room or well-defined space, then the ratio and group size is determined by the age of the youngest child, unless each group of children is clearly separated and the appropriate child care staff member-to-child ratios and group sizes, if applicable, for each age group are maintained.

At the time of the onsite inspection, there was only 1 caregiver present watching 2 classrooms of children ages 6 weeks to 4 years old. It was during nap time, and 2 of the children were awake in the 3-4 year old class room, and there were 2 children present in the infant room, one of which was also awake.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

Upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan it is recommended that the license be renewed without change in status.
