- The signature of the responsible party and a date.



The lead caregivers were given a variance to complete the educational requirements of licensing rule R400.8122(5)(d). They have completed the CEU's and are awaiting the final observation and test to receive their certificates.

The program director was given a variance to meet the 18 semester hours of coursework in Early childhood education or child development. Once she receives the 18 semester hours she can qualify under R400.8113(7)(b). She plans to enroll in classes this spring and is awaiting approval from TEACH.

## III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center's records, including staff records and children's records.

Staff records include background checks and training information. Children's records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the inspection, the center was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

**R 400.8110            Applicant; licensee; licensee designee; requirements.**

**(10) Written approval from the department must be obtained before making any changes in the terms of the license, including but not limited to, adding use space, changing age groups served, changing program components, changing the capacity of the center, or making changes to a room or well-defined space that will result in a change in capacity of the room or well-defined space.**

The licensee moved the toddlers into different classrooms which could result in the change of capacity of the center without prior written permission from the department.

**R 400.8161            Emergency procedures.**

**(6) A tornado drill program, consisting of at least 2 tornado drills between the months of March through November, must be established and implemented.**

Only one tornado drill was completed during the months of March – November.

**R 400.8350            Toilets; hand washing sinks.**

**(5) Hand washing sinks must have warm running water not to exceed 120 degrees Fahrenheit.**

The portable sink in the infant room does not maintain warm water.

**Consultation provided:**


We discussed outdoor time. Children need to be taken outside after three hours if weather permits. Temperatures should be set by the center, keeping in mind that cold weather does not cause illness. Licensee need to inform parents children will be taken outside daily and parents need to bring appropriate outdoor clothing.

I instructed licensee to add to Crisis Management plan more information on how infants will be care for and transported if there is a need to relocate during an emergency. Also,

to remove the crisis management plan from the parent board to a place accessible to staff.

#### IV. RECOMMENDATION

Upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, I recommend the issuance of a regular license to this child care facility.
